#### **Environmental Roles and Responsibilities**

#### 1. Top Management

- Establish and approve environmental policies and objectives.
- Ensure compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.
- Allocate resources for environmental management programs.
- Review environmental performance through audits and reports.
- Promote a culture of environmental responsibility across the organization.

## 2. Environmental / Sustainability Manager (EHS / EMS Lead)

- Develop, implement, and maintain the Environmental Management System (EMS).
- Monitor compliance with environmental laws, permits, and company standards.
- Conduct risk assessments, environmental impact studies, and audits.
- Coordinate waste management, pollution prevention, and resource efficiency programs.
- Train employees on environmental awareness and best practices.
- Report environmental performance to top management.

### 3. Department Heads / Line Managers

- Ensure environmental policies and procedures are implemented within their departments.
- Monitor resource usage (energy, water, raw materials) and reduce wastage.
- Maintain safe handling, storage, and disposal of hazardous materials.
- Investigate and report environmental incidents.
- Encourage employees to follow environmental practices.

#### 4. Supervisors / Team Leaders

- Ensure team compliance with environmental policies and safe practices.
- Identify potential environmental hazards and take corrective actions.
- Encourage reporting of environmental issues or near-misses.
- Support employee participation in sustainability initiatives.

#### 5. Employees

• Follow all environmental rules, procedures, and training guidelines.

- Segregate and dispose of waste properly.

- Manage and minimize environmental impacts of their activities.
- Ensure safe handling, storage, and transport of materials.

- Provide input and feedback on environmental performance.
- Collaborate in conservation and sustainability programs.
